Rules and Regulations

- All poultry breeds will be judged to the standards set down in the Australian Poultry Standards (2nd Edition, 2011). Old English Game will be judged to the Atkinson plates as per the Australian Poultry Standards (2nd Edition, 2011).
- All exhibits are to be entered under the name of the owner of the fowl.
- The Club will **NOT** under any circumstances hold itself responsible for any loss or any damage of exhibits.
- No birds are to be handled by anyone other than the judge or chief steward during judging.
- No photographs of birds are to be taken until the completion of judging.
- When photographs are taken, only the owner will remove their bird from the pen and return it.
- If an exhibit is entered in the incorrect class, there will be no provision for correction of pen number, however, it will be at the judge's discretion to consider the exhibit in the correct class.
- If the Judge considers an exhibit **NOT** of sufficient merit, no award will be made.
- Any bird dyed or otherwise interfered with will be **DISQUALIFIED** and the exhibitor dealt with as the committee thinks fit.
- Should a dispute arise for which no special rule is laid down, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the committee whose decision will be final.
- For the protection of exhibitors, no birds will be allowed to leave the Poultry Pavilion unless authorised by the Chief Steward.
- After the show, birds will only be released by having a steward in attendance when penning out.
- Any exhibit found to be infected with **vermin or disease** will be disqualified and **MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE POULTRY PAVILION**.
- All birds are to be penned ready for Judging by 8.30 am on the morning of the show.
- If the advertised judge/s is not available, the committee will attempt to contact all exhibitors to advise of the changes.
- Exhibitors will be permitted to enter the pavilion during judging at their discretion and under the control of the Chief Steward.
- After the award of Grand Champion Fowl of Show has been decided, the reserve exhibit from the same section is eligible for Reserve Grand Champion Bird of Show.
- The club reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
- All exhibitors must be registered with the Feather Clubs Association of Qld Inc. before penning birds.
- Any exhibitor found not a member of FCAQ Inc. will not be entitled to any compensation in the event of a claim, as per the FCAQ Inc. policies.
- Watering and feeding of birds are the responsibility of the owner, it would be preferable if feeding does not take place during judging.
