Delicious breakfast from 8.00am, morning tea and lunch will be available for purchase. EFTPOS facilities will be available.

Junior Section: This section is open to exhibitors under 16 years of age with **up to 2 birds** per person and these birds must be penned by the relevant junior exhibitor. There is no entry fee for these 2 entries and they are only eligible for Junior Section awards.

Developmental Section: This section is for breeds or varieties under development and/or not recognised by the Australian Poultry Standards. Entries for this section are not eligible for major/special awards except for "*Champion Developmental Class Exhibit*". Classes may be split up in this section where sufficient entries are received.

Conditions of Entry

1. **The applicable entry fees MUST be paid for at the time of sending entries.** Please make cheques payable to "Moreton Bay Regional Poultry Club Inc". If you wish to pay your entry fees by direct deposit, please contact David Simons on email dsimons1@bigpond.com to make the necessary arrangements.
2. The Club reserves the right to refuse any exhibitor or entry without explanation.
3. As separate classes may be created (at the discretion of the Club) where sufficient entries warrant it, please state the colour/variety on your entry form when exhibiting in ARC (Any Recognised Colour), AORC (Any Other Recognised Colour) or AORV (Any Other Recognised Variety) classes. "Recognised" means breeds and colours/varieties recognised by the Australian Poultry Standards.
4. During the judging, all exhibits will be in the custody of the stewards and shall not be touched or handled by the owner or any persons other than the judge or the stewards, unless previous consent from the Chief Steward has been obtained.
5. During the judging, exhibitors are asked to vacate the judging aisle/area to allow the judges and stewards sufficient space to do their jobs.
6. The Club accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to exhibits.
7. Any parasite infected or diseased fowls will be disqualified and removed from the pavilion.
8. The judges' decisions shall be considered final and no discussion concerning the matter will be entered into.
9. Water containers will be provided in each pen for the well-being of exhibits.
10. Penning can be done between 1.00 and 6.00pm on Saturday afternoon, or between 6.30 and 9.00am on Sunday morning. Please note that waterfowl entries can only be penned on Sunday morning, due to the waterfowl pens not being able to be locked up overnight.
11. All exhibits are to be penned by 9.00am and remain penned until released by the Chief Steward.
12. All Queensland exhibitors must hold a 2025 FCAQ Exhibitors Registration Number.
13. The show will be run with reference to the "**Biosecurity Guidelines for Exhibition Poultry: National Biosecurity Manual**" as appropriate.
