How to bid: Attached to the pen containing the pair will be a bid sheet. To place a bid, all you need to do is write your name and bid amount on the sheet. Other bidders will do the same throughout the day. The highest recorded bid for each lot by auction close will be the winning bid for that lot.

### Conditions:

1. By bidding in the Queensland Ancona Club Inc silent auction, each bidder agrees to these auction rules.
2. Bidding starts at 6.00am on Saturday 12 July 2025, with closing time for bids being 1.00pm that day.
3. Auction birds are not to be removed from the pavilion until the end of the show when unpenning is allowed to commence (usually around 3.00pm).
4. The sale are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds.
5. No statement made in writing, or made orally at the auction or elsewhere, shall be deemed such a warranty, representation, or assumption of liability.
6. Payment for lot purchased must be made in full on the day of the auction to the club Secretary Treasurer David Simons.
7. Payment can be made by cash, direct debit (with photo proof), or a cheque made payable to the Queensland Ancona Club Inc.
8. The winning bidder must pick up their winning lot the day of the auction unless special arrangements are made. Any lot left unclaimed, without prior arrangements will be sold to the next highest bidder.
9. The Queensland Ancona Club Inc reserves the right to add or withdraw items, without notice, to or from the auction.
10. Each person bidding assumes full risks related to the auction and lots obtained at the auction.
11. Each bidder agrees to hold harmless from any liability arising indirectly from the Queensland Ancona Club Inc, their elected and appointed officials, members, the event organisers, and/or volunteers connected with the auction.
